Dharashiv, Maharashtra – 413501 for establishment of new Homoeopathic Medical College with admission intake capacity of 100 seats for BHMS course under section 29 of NCH Act 2020 for academic year 2026- 27– reg

Sir,

The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARBH) has received an application for starting of new BHMS course in Wellness Homoeopathic College and Research Centre, Gut No. 253, Alani Gadpati TA, Dist. Dharashiv, Maharashtra – 413501 with intake capacity of 100 seats for the academic session 2026-27 as per the regulations in force under NCH Act, 2020. The Letter of Intent (LOI) inspection of the college was conducted on 01.04.2026, followed by an opportunity of hearing on 24.04.2026. LOI was issued to college on 28.04.2026. The Letter of Permission (LOP) Inspection of college was conducted on 16.06.2026 and 17.06.2026 followed by hearing on 09.07.2026. MARBH has examined the College to ascertain whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standards as per the prevailing regulations under section 29 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

A. College Functioning:

- a) Teaching Faculty: There is deficiency of 01 teaching faculty:
 - i. Physiology Department: Associate Professor 01 not available.

B. Hospital Functioning:

- a) Labor room is not functional.
- b) NABH/NABL accreditation is not available.

C. Salary: Salary of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff is not as per MES, 2024.

2. Keeping in view the inspection report and compliance submitted during hearing, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has decided **to issue conditional letter of permission (LOP) for starting new BHMS course to Wellness Homoeopathic College and Research Centre, Gut No. 253, Alani Gadpati TA, Dist. Dharashiv, Maharashtra – 413501 with intake capacity of 100 seats for the academic session 2026-27 on the basis of following conditions:**

- i. Teaching faculty: Associate Professor 01 in Department of Physiology shall be appointed and registered on AEBAS portal as per First and Third Schedule of National Commission For Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards For Homoeopathic Colleges And Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024

- ii. Hospital shall be functional as per A. (3) and (16) of Second Schedule of National Commission For Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards For Homoeopathic Colleges And Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024
- iii. Salary of teaching, hospital and non-teaching staff shall be as per First Schedule of National Commission For Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards For Homoeopathic Colleges And Attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2024

Deficiencies mentioned above should be rectified within a period of 30 days and the compliance report must be submitted to the undersigned, failing which conditional permission issued will be withdrawn without further notice

3. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counselling Authority of State/UT Government as designated by Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling authority of the state/UT Government.
4. The Category-wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board
